- 3. Written application
- 4. Personal Interview

Applicants who are selected for the final level will be notified by the May 15th and may be asked to have a 15-minute interview.

Applicants may be asked to submit the latest school report cards and or transcripts, or any formal documentation that supports your scholarship request to the interview.
